na Wellness Spa is the type of spot a celebrity would hit xury spa services.



he first thing I thought about when I walked in and saw beaded doorways and paper anging from the ceiling was Zoolander and Magatu's Pier 12 Spa – a spot for "deep, axation."







Spa services range from waxing and skin treatments to wellness and energy therapies.

Prices start in the \$30 range, but four different membership options are available and range from \$75 to \$150 per month.



Don't leave without stopping by the tea bar. Or go just for it.

Their tea lounge has over 100 loose leaf teas from all over the world that can be made hot or cold. The selection is almost overwhelming, but look for the miniature book that describes them all to help guide yourself through it.







But if you can't find a service or a tea that you like, look at the shelves.

While you'll find your typical spa store selection (spiky massage balls, Da Vinci Tools, sleep masks and bath bombs), Urbana introduced me to products I'd never seen before, like bright green Japenese wine and Himalayan salt lamps.


